Go With The Snow

This winter is snow joke, but if you're not into skiing The Greatest Snow on Earth, give these activities a try.

Snowshoeing

If you can walk, you can snowshoe. The <u>Solitude Nordic Center</u> and <u>Sundance Resort</u> both offer 10k of well-marked snowshoe trails. Both resorts offer special evening events for snowshoeing under the moon. <u>Utah Outdoor</u> <u>Adventures</u> and <u>All Seasons Adventures</u> offer a variety of snowshoeing tours that start in Park City. <u>White Pine Touring</u> in Park City also offers a variety of tours including a Historic Snowshoeing Tour. You can also rent snowshoes at many of the local winter sports shops (<u>REI, Canyon Sports, Jans, AJ Motion</u>) and hit your favorite local hiking trail.

Bobsled Experience

Take a ride down the 2002 Olympic Winter Games Sliding Track with the Winter Bobsled Experience at Utah Olympic Park (3419 Olympic Pkwy, Park City) with a professional bobsled driver.

Yurt Dinner

Eat a gourmet meal after traveling to a cozy yurt tent under the stars. With <u>The Viking Yurt</u> experience at Park City Mountain Resort, take a 23-minute sleigh ride out to the yurt before your European dining experience. Build up your appetite with a guided snowshoe tour out to the yurt at <u>Solitude Mountain Resort</u> and <u>Soldier</u> Hollow Nordic Center.

Ice Castles

The name says it all - this frozen attraction features thousand of icicles hand-placed by professional ice artists along with tunnels and slides. Located just outside Soldier Hollow Nordic Center in Midway (2002 Olympic Drive). Add on a sleigh ride for an extra special experience.

Snow Tubing

<u>Woodward Park City</u> (3863 Kilby Rd.) is the closest formal tubing location to Salt Lake and has both longer and shorter hills for children ages 3-5. The <u>Toyota Tubing Hill at Soldier</u> <u>Hollow</u> boasts the longest tubing lanes in Utah. <u>Wasatch Parc</u> in Eden (3567 Nordic Valley Way) takes inspiration from the French and has two bobsled-style track lanes that will zig-zag you down the hill. Check age/height requirements before you go if you have younger children, no lap riding is permitted at any of the sites listed here.

Dog Sled Tour

Join North Forty Escapes or Wasatch Adventure Guides for one-hour dog sled tours at Stillman Ranch in Oakley. Both offer transportation options from Park City. Think about adding on a snowmobile trip for a full day of fun!
