# May The Forest Be With You

These boots were made for hiking. While the snow melts at the upper elevations, check out these lower elevation hikes for spring.

# Lagoon Trail

The trail follows Farmington Creek through a forest while skirting along the back of Lagoon amusement park. Round trip the trail is 2.6 miles and is also good for biking. Access the trail from Ezra T. Clark Park (400 W State Street, Farmington).

### **Ensign Peak**

A classic one-mile hike with an amazing view of the valley. The well-marked trail head is located above the Capitol at 164 Ensign Vista Dr. (Salt Lake City).

# **Living Room Trail**

It's called The Living Room because the rocks have been arranged to resemble living room chairs. This is a great place to watch the sunset from. The moderate hike is 2.5 miles round trip. The trail begins at the top of the University of Utah's Research Park, 383 Colorow Rd.

### Bear Canyon Suspension Bridge

The bridge spans 185 feet across Bear Canyon and connects the Bonneville Shoreline Trail. Find the trail at Orson Smith Park (12625 Highland Dr., Draper).

## Battle Creek Falls

A quick 1.5 mile hike to a 50-foot waterfall. The trail head has plenty of parking at 1800 E 200 S, Pleasant Grove.
