# All Quiet on the Homefront

We know that sometimes sound travels in community living. Use these tips to help reduce sounds that may travel throughout the community.

## Acoustic Panels

Acoustic panels absorb sound waves and prevent those waves from reflecting off hard surfaces. Arrange panels in a <u>mosaic design</u> or purchase a <u>printed picture design</u>.

## **Hang Heavy Curtains**

Not only do <u>heavy curtains</u> help dampen noise, but they help balance room temperature by insulating against heat and cold, and serve a blackout function as well.

## Seal Door Gaps

Seal off the bottom of the door from noise and airflow. Get a version that <u>slides with the door</u> or sits in <u>front of the door</u>. We also love these animal-shaped stoppers.

#### Hang Fabric On The Walls

Sound is absorbed by soft surfaces, so hanging a <u>tapestry</u>, <u>quilt</u>, <u>rug</u> or <u>blanket</u> on your walls will help dampen noise.

#### Add Furniture

Big heavy pieces of furniture against the walls can help absorb sound. The classic <u>IKEA Billy</u> <u>bookcase</u> comes in white, black and birch. Hang a blanket on the wall behind the furniture for additional sound dampening.

#### Slow Cooking in the Summer

When it's too hot to turn on your oven, put your slow cooker to work instead. Although you may think about cozy soups and stews when you think about your slow cooker, in the summer you avoid heating up your house and have more time to spend outside as your meat cooks low and slow.
